**Re: Dr. Gabor Lukacs v. Canadian Transportation Agency**  
**– Court File No.: A-218-14**

This is in response to the Applicant's letter dated February 18, 2014.

With respect to the Applicant's request to file the Memorandum of Fact and Law and the Affidavit of Catherine Murphy related to the Federal Court proceeding in *Hollier v. Public Service Commission of Canada et al.* T-1659-08, the Respondent, Canadian Transportation Agency, would object. A reading of the material the Applicant proposes to file reveals that the issues before the Federal Court in *Hollier* have little to do with the issues raised by the Applicant in this proceeding. In *Hollier*, the issues addressed by the Interveners were whether the Applicant's personal information could be included in the Board's decision and whether the decision could be posted on the Board's website. In the current Application, the issue is not whether the Applicant is entitled to a full copy of the Agency's decision. Rather, the Applicant challenges the Agency's authority to redact personal information from documents contained in the Agency's file before providing him with copies of same.

The Agency takes no position regarding the Applicant's objections to the Intervener's materials.
